NHCA Staff Introduce Creative New Classes for Engaging Learning

At New Hope Christian Academy, our talented staff continue to find innovative ways to make learning both fun and meaningful. This year, several new courses, designed by our creative team, highlight the importance of connective learning and bringing education to life for our students.

One exciting new addition is the high school course, "Micah 6:8 - A Biblical Approach to Economics, Politics, and Financial Literacy." Conceptualized by Pastor Kim and Ms. Asia, written by Pastor Kim, and taught by Ms. Asia, this year-long program equips 8th-12th grade students to explore justice, mercy, and humility through economics, politics, and financial literacy. Students will apply Biblical principles while participating in service projects like the "Nourish Hope" initiative around Thanksgiving.

In our science department, Ms. Alicia has introduced a new class inspired by Roald Dahl's George's Marvelous Medicine, first used in our summer STEAM camp. This curriculum creatively connects reading comprehension, writing, and science by using the book as the novel in language arts and conducting hands-on experiments based on the story. Even our kindergarten class is getting a personal touch, with Ms. Shelby designing fun worksheets to help students learn to spell their names and use capital letters.

At NHCA, we're proud of our teachers' creativity and commitment to making learning exciting and meaningful for all!


Celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month Through Art
